## **Overview for Parents, Carers & Staff**

This document should be read in conjunction with the full policy

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<ul> <li>A medicine form needs to be completed for any medicines to be given (including 'over the counter' medicine)</li> <li>All medicine must be in date</li> <li>All medicine should be collected form school and disposed of appropriately</li> <li>We will administer prescribed medicines in your child's name</li> <li>A responsible adult must bring and collect the medicine to the school office</li> <li>We will administer 'over the counter' medicines as follows: paracetamol, antihistamine and travel sickness medicine</li> <li>We will administer emergency paracetamol with parental consent</li> <li>All inhalers should be clearly named and in date</li> <li>We will record and double sign the time, date, dosage of medicines administered</li> <li>We will text parents when medicines have been administered</li> <li>Only teachers and other named staff in school will have the responsibility of administering medicines</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Medicines will not be administered without completion of a form</li> <li>Ibuprofen will not be administered, unless it is prescribed by a doctor</li> <li>Aspirin will not be administered unless it is by a doctor</li> <li>Children must not bring medicine to school themselves</li> <li>Medicines must not be left in your child's bag/care</li> <li>Homeopathic medicines will not be administered by school staff unless prescribed by a doctor</li> <li>Children will not be allowed to share inhalers or other medicines</li> <li>During residential visits teachers will administer medicine but will not send a text message after administration as they are in loco parentis</li> </ul>
