a) A Christmas tree is decorated with 12 red baubles, 10 blue ones, and 36 silver bells. How many decorations are there altogether?
b) Subtract 44 and 13 from 100. What is the answer?

a) A piece of wrapping ribbon is 240 cm long. How many 8 cm strips can be cut from it?
b) $100-20-50-12=$

a) Mrs Claus bakes 280 mini Christmas puddings. She puts holly berries on top of half of them. How many do not have holly berries on top?
b) What is 8 less than 673 ?
