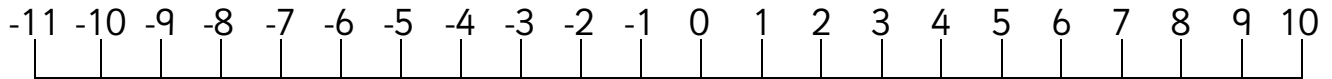

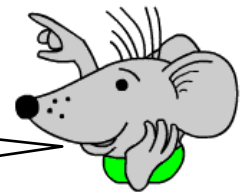

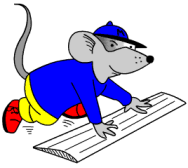

She spent £2 600 on a new TV. How much was in her bank now? $\dots\dots\dots$

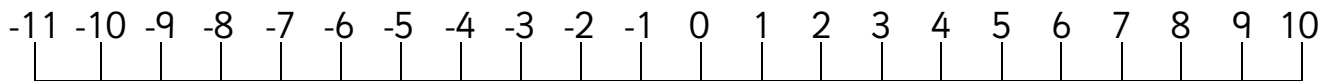
16. Ali's overdrawn bank statement showed he had $-\text{£}368.50$. He bought
