Key Vocabulary

Religion	a particular system of faith and worship, which may involve belief in and worship of a superhuman controlling power, especially a personal God or gods.
Family	A group of people all linked by a particular bond.
Community	A wider group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.
Church	A building used for public Christian worship.
Mosque	A Muslim place of worship.
Temple	A Hindu place of worship.
Welcoming Ceremonies	A rite of passage where a person is welcomed into a particular religion.
Moral Values	Standards of behaviour; principles of right and wrong.
Precepts	A general rule intended to regulate behaviour or thought.
