Next week, the class's new teacher(s) will be visiting their new class at the infants. The purpose of the visit is to meet and introduce themselves to the children and observe their learning. This will be in preparation for the children's transition morning at the juniors the following week (Tuesday 22nd). The Year 3 Team are very much looking forward to this and have planned some lovely activities for the children to enjoy. During the morning, the children will also have a guided tour of the juniors. Please remember children do not need to be dropped off at the juniors, they need to register at the infant school as usual. The infant staff will be walking the children over at 9.15am. Children do not need to bring anything other than a named water bottle and sun hat (or coat if the weather is cooler).

If your child is feeling worried, please reassure them that it is okay to feel like this and they will settle in no time. If your child has any questions, ask them to write them down and pop them in an envelope. They can hand them to their new class teacher on the transition day. On the day, we will do our best to answer them. In addition, if you have any questions or worries please do not hesitate to email the junior school office and they will forward your email on to your child's class teacher.
