Security & Emergency Information

- We undertake our own risk assessments for the journey. All activities are fully risk assessed.
- Potentially 92 children with up to between 10 and 14 school staff.
- A 'first aider' on site at all times.
- The School staff bedrooms will be distributed evenly within the dorms, so we can care for the children at bedtime, night time and in getting up in the morning

Why?

- It provides an experience for their social and recreational skills development.
- Chance to spend a night away with friends.
- Develop organisation skills – packing and unpacking. Keeping track of belongings, etc
- Develop some independence.

What do we need to take?

- School will provide a kit list of all the things the children will need to bring.
- Children do not necessarily need clothes bought especially for the visit – due to the activities sometimes undertaken and the weather conditions, the activities are based outside so don't pack your favourite clothes - waterproofs are essential!
- Much of the time is spent outside. Please read the kit list carefully.

KIT LIST - all items named pleased – Castleton Residential 2023

- 1 complete change of clothes – trousers must not be denim
- Hat and gloves (if cold) and sunhat and sun cream (if hot)
- Outdoor footwear, e.g. shoes, trainers or boots (wellies are not suitable for some activities – please avoid if possible)
- The above items need to be hard wearing as they may get wet and muddy
- Nightwear
- Adequate changes of underwear, including extra socks
- 1 small towel
- Wash bag with soap, flannel toothbrush , toothpaste
- Comb or brush
- Tissues
- Band for tying long hair back if needed
- Travel bands (if required for travel sickness)
- Book to read
- Small soft toy
- £5-£10 recommended spending money (maximum £10) There are 2 shops to visit.
- Case or holdall – preferably not overfull (that your child can carry!) and a small rucksack.
- Plastic bags for wet, dirty clothing
- Packed lunch for day 1 (easier in disposable bag) and 2 snacks
- Water bottle
