Using Grid References and Keys:

1. What is located at the grid reference 607562?

Clogwyn Station

2. What is located at the grid reference 624531? *Remember to use the key to find out what this symbol means.*

Nature Reserve



3. Can you see a big blue bird at this location in real life?

No, it is only a symbol used to represent something in the real world.

4. What is at grid reference 658542? *Remember to use the key to find out what these symbols mean.*

Parking

5. Look at grid reference 648525. What can you do here? *Remember to use the key to find out what this symbol means.*

You can camp. This is a symbol for a camp site.



6. Find two more features that visitors might want to see in Snowdonia. What are they? What are the grid references for each feature?

1. You are standing on the summit of Snowdon. Which compass direction does the train journey follow to Clogwyn station?

North

2. Is Llyn Llydaw to the west or east of Glaslyn?

East

3. You are in Pen-y-Pas. In which direction will you walk if you take the Miners' Track?

South
