Independent Shopping Permission

You will notice that the timetable contains free time for the children to have time to independently browse and shop in Stratford. This has been risk assessed in line with local authority guidelines and the children will be given strict instructions for how long they have (45 minutes), where to find Dobcroft adults at a fixed meeting point, to remain in groups of 4 and the bounds within which they must remain (a pedestrianised street). If you do decide to send your child with money, we suggest £10 and it will be your child's responsibility to look after it throughout the week. For your child to have this independent time of browsing and shopping in Stratford, you must grant permission for this – via this Google Form. If you do not wish for your child to shop independently, then they can either relax at the meeting point with Dobcroft adults, or go shopping in a group with a Dobcroft adult. https://forms.gle/kJriosPCwP5fGeMYA

Before we leave for Stratford

Your child needs to arrive at school at 8:50am and they do not have to wear school uniform. Those with medicines to drop off – these will be able to be passed to staff in the office from 8:50am. Luggage is to be left under the canopy.

We are travelling on two coaches which we expect to depart at 10am. Children will need to bring a packed lunch for this day - preferably in plastic bags so they don't have a mouldy lunchbox when they return at the end of the trip!

We hope to return by 3pm on the Friday, but this is dependent on the traffic. If we are going to be significantly late, we will inform you via text – please ensure that school has correct contact details.

Medication

If your child has an inhaler, this must be carried by them at all times. Other medication such as travel sickness tablets, hay fever tablets, creams etc. must be given to the designated medical lead the morning of the trip, labelled with the relevant paper work attached. Please contact the office for the relevant medical form (appendix 3) to accompany the medication on the day of the trip. It will save delays on departure day if you are able to fill in the medical details before you arrive at school.

Accommodation

Children will be in single gender dorms, with other children from Dobcroft. Sheets, duvets and pillows are provided. Dobcroft staff will also be sleeping in the same buildings so the children are able to find a familiar adult during the night if the need arises. Bedding is provided for the children.

Children will find out who they are sharing a bedroom with when they reach the Youth Hostel. They will have an opportunity to let their teachers know who they would like to share with before the trip. **No** food is allowed in the bedrooms – please do not pack snacks or sweets!
