The Year 3 classrooms are in the main building.

In your classroom, you will have a drawer to keep your personal belongings in. You are not allowed to bring any toys into school.

There will be space to hang up your bags and coats in your classroom and a space to keep your PE kit.

There are boy and girl toilets in the cloakrooms that are near your classroom.

School Day

When you arrive in the morning, your teacher will set a morning activity for you to complete whilst the register is taken.

8:45—You can enter your classroom and your teacher will be in there waiting to greet you.

8:45—9:10 Register, ordering lunches and morning task.

9:10 - 10:15 Lesson 1 (Maths or English)

10:15 - 10:40 Assembly

10:40 - 11:00 Playtime

11:00 -12:00 Lesson 2 (maths or English)

12:00 -1:10 Lunchtime

1:10 - 2:15 Whole class reading (some afternoons)

2:15 - 2:30—Class activity (this is usually outdoors)

2:30 - 3:30 Wider curriculum

In the afternoon, you will learn the wider curriculum subjects. These include: geography, history, art, D.T science, R.E, P.E, computing, personal development, French and music—there are so many exciting subjects to learn about!

Equipment

In the Junior School, we ask you to bring your own equipment to school. We would like you to bring:

- Several pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- Rubber
- Ruler (30 cm is best)
- Glue stick
- Coloured pencils
- A Green biro
- A whiteboard pen

You do not need a pencil case, however if you would like to keep your equipment in one, nothing too big as larger pencil cases don't fit into our trays so you would be asked to take it home. You must remember to look after your equipment (and school's). It's a good idea to label all equipment from home and have some spares to keep in your tray in a clear plastic wallet.

You also need to bring a water bottle into school. This must have your name on and contain only water. There is drinking water in the school taps where you can refill your bottle.

Back Yard

You will have your morning break time on the back yard. We do not allow ball games during this time, but you will have a chance to play with your friends.

At playtimes, you can bring a **healthy** snack to eat. You keep this in your drawer until playtime. Here are some examples of the healthy snacks you can bring:
