

New Vocabulary	
<b>Creation</b>	How something first came to exist
<b>Old Testament</b>	The first part of The Bible, taking place before Jesus was born.
<b>Genesis</b>	The first book in The Bible, which includes the creation story and the story of Noah
<b>The fall</b>	How Adam and Eve disobeyed God when they ate the fruit of the tree of knowledge.
<b>Promise</b>	A special agreement to do something or not to do something
<b>Covenant / Pact</b>	A two-sided promise between 2 people or groups, or between God and people.
<b>Prophets</b>	People from the Old Testament who predicted the coming of Jesus
<b>Forgiveness</b>	Choosing to stop being angry or upset with someone, even if they did something wrong.

Christians believe that god created the world in 6 days. Then on the 7<sup>th</sup> day he rested. God thought that his creation was good.
