Writing Activity – Where would you like to visit?

- Where in the world would you like to visit? Research the place online and find out as much information about it. Things to research might be:
 - What is special about the place? Why would tourists visit?
 - What traditions does the place have? E.g. religious festivals
 - What is the weather like? How are the seasons different to ours?
 - How far away is it? What is the time difference?
 - What language is spoken?
 - What is the currency?

- Write a report to describe what you know about the place and why you would like to travel there. The aim of the writing is to include as many of the co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions as possible from the list. Look back at yesterday's learning if you need a reminder on conjunctions. Remember to separate your reasons and information into separate paragraphs.

- Share your writing with someone else. You could email it your teacher. Show them the coordinating and subordinating conjunctions that you have used. You could highlight them in two different colours.
