Key Vocabulary

Wisdom	The quality of having experience, knowledge, and good judgement.
Teaching	Ideas or principles taught by an authority.
Authority	The power or right to give orders, make decisions, and enforce obedience.
Jesus	Christians believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He came to earth to teach about love and fellowship. He represents the person that all Christians must strive to be. Muslims don't believe Jesus was the son of God, but they do revere him as a holy prophet.
Prophet	A person people think is an inspired teacher or proclaimer of the will of God.
Muhammed (pbuh)	Muslims believe that Muhammad (pbuh) is the last in a line of prophets that includes Moses, Abraham, and Isa (Jesus). Muhammad (pbuh) proclaimed that the Quran was the last Book of God, and that he himself was the last Prophet.
Peace be upon Him or pbuh	A phrase that Muslims say after they say the name Muhammed
Christianity, Islam, Hinduism	Three religions that are followed in the world
Muslin	A person who follows the religion of Islam
