Structure

Title	The title of your text should clearly show what your topic is about. If it is a leaflet, it may have a catchy title or slogan to attract the target audience's attention.
Opening	Persuasion texts often begin with a question. The topic sentence of the opening paragraph should introduce the main point of view.
Paragraph 1	Have at least three clear points to support your argument and develop each by providing examples.
Paragraph 2	This is the main body of your text and will include lots of persuasive devices to convince the audience.
Paragraph 3	You should recognise there is an alternative viewpoint, but do not elaborate on it; simply counter argue with another point to support your view.
Conclusion	Summarise your points and reiterate the opening/title.
