#### Where was this picture taken?

I think that this photograph was taken on a bus or a tram because people are sitting in rows and other people are holding onto poles.

Why are some people standing up?

Some people are standing up because there must be no seats left on the busy bus or tram.

What was the weather like on this day? How do you know?

I can tell that the weather is warm and sunny because I can see sunlight on the floor. I can also see one person wearing shorts and one person wearing sandals.

What can you tell about the person stood on the right of the picture?

I can tell that the person stood on the right of the picture might be younger than the others because they are shorter.

Activity 5

What is the job of the person in the dark blue shirt?

The man wearing the dark blue shirt is a dentist.

What might the man be saying to the woman?

The man might be explaining to the woman what the x-ray shows and what he needs to do to her teeth.

Why is the woman wearing a bib?

The woman is wearing a bib to protect her clothes whilst the dentist treats her teeth.

#### Why is the man wearing gloves?

The man is wearing gloves to protect himself and his patient from infection because he is going to put his hand into her mouth.
