 Plants don't have straws to suck water up, but they do have...



ROOTS

Plants have **roots**, which do a similar job to the straw.

Roots absorb water and nutrients from the soil.

Plants need these things to groW.

- To keep the plant healthy, roots need room to reach out and grow.
- They don't like being squashed like these hamsters!



• Roots also anchor the plant into the ground.

• Imagine what would happen in the wind if nothing was holding the plant into the soil.
