Challenge answers

- 1. 7/10 6/10 = 1/106/10 - 5/10 = 1/105/10 - 4/10 = 1/10
- Examples are: 3/5 - 2/5 = 1/5 8/5 - 7/5 = 1/5 10/5 - 9/5 = 1/5
- 3. 9/10 3/10 = 5/10 + 1/10 (both sides = 6/10)

5/5 - 3/5 = 1/5 +1/5 (both sides = 2/5)

- 4. 20/60
- 5. Yes! 8/10 = 4/5 4/5 - 4/5 = 0
- 6. Examples are: $1 - \frac{1}{2} = \frac{1}{2}$ $2 - \frac{1}{2} = \frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$
